Harry Shelton, of Ketchikan, died at Camp Dodge of influenza.

Business men of Cordova meet every Friday at lunch to discuss community affairs.

The Yukon potato crop has been harvested. It was a large crop and many of the spuds weigh six pounds each.

Thomas Taylor of Dawson, a pioneer, passed away recently.

One of Alaska's worst trails, that between Kaltag, a lower Yukon town, and Unalakleet, a Norton Sound coast point between St. Michael and Nome, is being given winter stake markings. Stakes along the trail, it is believed will help the mail carriers and their dog teams during the winter. Mail from Nome, St. Michael and Seward Peninsula points is carried over a strip of the Kaltag-Unalakleet trail during the winter. In the summer it runs through wilderness and is used by only the most daring "mushers," who by taking the seventy-mile trail, can save a 250-mile trip through the Yukon delta and across a strip of the Bering Sea to St. Michael. In the winter this trail is packed by snow but in the summer it is boggy and climbs or goes around thousands of nigger-heads.

Water shortage has materially interfered with the gold dredging operations on the northern part of Seward Peninsula this season. Reports from Candle says that little mining is going on. An operator on the Kugruk was unable to move his dredges down to the Keewalik because of the low water. Conditions at Bear Creek have been better, according to reports. Operators from the Innachuk section report fair success in dredging operations this year. The Cordocando Mining Company, one of the largest concerns in that district, reports unusual success.

The harvesting of the gardens at Nenana planted last spring showed remarkable results from new ground. Nearly all the vegetables attained a good size and 5-pound turnips were a common sight. All manner of vegetables were planted and the residents of the town are pleased with the results of their summer's work.

Members of the city council of Cordova hereafter will be elected for a term of two years, the mayor for one year; and the offices of the mayor, town clerk, and town treasurer will become elective if the ordinance passed by the city council at a regular meeting in the city hall receives the approval of voters at a referendum vote to be held November 5.
