RETURNED RUPERT MAN DIES OF "FLU"

News of the death of Bert Pearse has reached the city. A telegram came yesterday from his brother Ernest, who left here with Mrs. Pearse on Thursday night, to see him in Vancouver, where he was in the King Edward Hospital suffering from influenza. Ben Self and Jack Bradbury saw him in the hospital last week and he seemed to be getting better. The deceased, who was well known in town, was with the St. Eloi, the returned soldiers' boat, all fall, fishing off the Queen Charlottes. He left here with the 1st Pioneers, and was gassed at Ypres. He has many friends in town who will regret his loss.

His father, Sam Pearse, has been communicated with. He is located at Inverness Cannery and is one of the old timers of the city.

A military funeral will take place from the chapel of the B. C. Undertakers at 2 p. m. on Wednesday when all returned soldiers are expected to be present.

WITHDRAWS TROOPS FROM FINLAND

(Special via G. T. P. Telegraphs.) London, Nov. 18.—General von Der Goltz, German commander in Finland, has informed the Finnish Government that German troops are being withdrawn from Finland in order to avoid a conflict with British forces which are expected here soon.

Despatches add that General Mannerheim, commander of the Finnish Government forces, will be governor of Finland, and that a coalition Government will be in power.
