Energy Needed in Land Settlement.

It is to be hoped that the Provincial Government will keep the Land Settlement scheme well to the fore and push it for all it is worth. We believe they will do this for they seem as anxious as anybody to make it a success. If they are determined in the matter they will find the people with them. If they weaken they will find that the people will have no further use for them. It is a vital question, one that is engaging a great deal of attention today.

It is not to be expected that, in what is more or less of an experimental scheme, everything will work perfectly at first. If it is found that there are amendments needed to the act to make it more workable it is to be hoped that the Government will have the courage to go forward. Delay just now would be fatal, for it is right now that the scheme is needed. It should prove a first rate auxiliary to any soldier settlement scheme, as under the act returned men get a very decided preference. It is not as a settlement of the returned soldier problem that it is needed, however, so much as to act as a safety valve to help absorb those who will be elbowed out on the return of the men from the front.

Publicity Needed As Well as Energy.

Women are now doing the work of men much more than they ever did before. The places of those who went to the war have to a large extent been taken by women. Many of the positions will still be kept by women and many men will find themselves without any occupation. Some of them would like to farm if they could find the land and get it on reasonable terms. For these and for immigrants who have been elbowed out in other countries, provision must be made, and the uncultivated lands of the north are open to them if the Government takes hold of the situation with energy and determination. They have begun well. Let them keep it going and see that the fertile lands along the railway between here and the province of Alberta are made available for the right class of settlers and that a campaign of publicity be initiated in the near future for the purpose of getting the settlers here.

Sometimes Impossible To Explain Everything.

There are often seeming contradictions in newspaper reports which people do not understand. Statements are published which at the time are true, but owing to changes in conditions, plans do not materialize. It is not always possible to explain why this is. There are reasons for the changes often that cannot be published. That puts the newspaper in a bad light and makes it seem as if false or misleading reports were published, when as a matter of fact if the whole story were told it would be perfectly clear to everyone.

That sort of thing has happened of late. Seemingly contradictory reports have been published in The News and it is not possible to explain. We give as much of the news as possible but sometimes there are lines over which it is impossible to pass. The people must be satisfied or not as they see fit. Of this they may be sure, however, that the reports are given in good faith and if anything goes awry it is not the fault of this paper and often not the fault of those who gave the information.

Captain Hayward Resigns Seat.

Captain Hayward of Cowichan has resigned his seat in the Provincial Legislature. On a former occasion he sent a resignation across the sea, but it was received by the Conservative Association and held by them. Then a new association was formed in Cowichan for the purpose of accepting the resignation. They said that as Capt. Hayward was only in England and not at the front and his absence left the district unrepresented he should either return at once or send in his resignation. There was a good deal of correspondence in regard to the matter and the upshot is that the resignation is now in the hands of Mr. Speaker and an election will be held to fill the vacant position.

Captain Hayward, who was a Conservative, represented the district well. Everyone was agreed that he was a suitable man for the position and that he had a great deal of ability. The only objection was that there was no one to speak for the district and that it was not necessary that an absentee should hold the position to the exclusion of some person who might otherwise be on the job.

Col. Peck is an absentee member, but he has really been fighting at the front, and now it seems very probable that he will return in time to take his seat in the house at the next session and Prince Rupert will then, for the first time in many years, have someone to voice her needs at the capital.
