Another Candidate Wanted for Mayor.

The News is looking for a candidate to represent its views to place before the people of this city for their approval or otherwise as chief magistrate for the coming year. Doubtless there are many with similar views, but unfortunately many of them are like most newspapermen, they have not the property qualification for the position. What we are looking for is a man who will advocate municipal groceries, municipal stationery shops, municipal hotels, municipal furniture shops, municipal fish dealers, municipal real estate and financial agents. When all these things are municipalized there will be no commercial advertising so we shall have to have municipal newspapers. Then will come the millennium.

Anyone who is prepared to advocate these reforms and have this question of big profits settled once and for all, will kindly call at the Daily News office and bring in a wad sufficiently large to compensate for the lost business which this paper will suffer and he will receive unqualified support.

Reasons Why We Should Municipalize.

It might be interesting to give a few of the reasons why it is necessary to have these lines of business municipalized. Take them in the order named. It has been the fate of a good many citizens in this and other towns to find in the currant sack mingled delicately with the dried fruit quantities of grit and other foreign substances which have no business there and which the grocers have been foisting on an unsuspecting public and charging for at the same rate as for currants. Sugar too has often been found to be not all pure, and very commonly apple and turnip pulp has been found mixed in very large quantities with fruits to make curious compounds known as and labelled "jam."

In stationery supplies there are no dilutions or impurities to speak of but the prices! It is rumored that pens often are sold at a profit of one hundred per cent. That is of course in Vancouver. Here things are different, but even here the profits are alleged to be much higher than would be the case in a municipal-owned shop.

Free Beds in Municipal Hotels.

In the hotels there should of course be a charge for meals and perhaps a slight, a very slight, consideration in exchange for drinks, but beds should be free. When the pauperized logger who has been working for the Imperial Munitions Board, returns from the Islands it is nothing short of criminal to charge him for his bed. Did he not earn his poor stipend in the sweat of his brow, enduring all the hardship and privations of the logging camp. To ask him to pay extortionate prices or even any price at all for a bed in which to sleep is undemocratic, disloyal, criminal. Let us break up the hotel trust once and for all and let the people into free beds.

Save Owners From Much Drudgery.

Of furniture shops it is hardly necessary to speak. Everyone knows that their charges are low and the only reason for asking that they be municipalized is to save the owners from the drudgery of waiting on customers who refuse to requite them according to their deserts.

The mayor and the fishermen have already asked for municipal fish wharves so there is no need to touch on that. The real estate dealers, however, have not been mentioned in this regard nor the insurance and financial men. They, poor wretches, are deserving of some assistance. Let us pay them big salaries to tell weird stories on behalf of the city instead of to prospective clients. Let us municipalize them so that people may get their real estate for nothing and their insurance free.

Then when everything else is municipalized, there being no Old Men's Home available, it will be necessary to provide free board and lodging for the helpless editors or else give them some municipal job, such as janitor or mayor. It is a great life if you only vote for municipal ownership of everything. Give the people newspapers at cost manufactured in a municipal mill and they will be happy for ever after. There must, however, be no charge for slush.
