A SHORTAGE OF XMAS TURKEYS THIS SEASON

As turkeys are selling very fast this Christmas the local merchants state that a shortage is likely to result before Christmas, in which case the more humble chicken will hold the spotlight on the dinner table. Turkeys are selling in Rupert at fifty cents a pound while it is said that Vancouver is getting at least sixty for them.

Cranberries are higher this Christmas, retailing at thirty-five cents a pound.

The table cluster raisins have not arrived here yet, as the U.S. embargo was slow in lifting on this Yule-tide commodity.

The crop of navel oranges is three times as large as it was last year, but the high prices have resulted in much of the crop not being sold. In order to get rid of it prices are dropping and in about a week's time oranges will be retailed at about forty per cent lower, than present prices.

"I have been constantly informed by my officers in charge of recruiting of the sterling service you have rendered in connection with recruiting for the Royal Air Force in Canada.

"I wish to take this opportunity of thanking you for your aid and congratulating you upon the splendid results achieved through your efforts.

"I wish also to say that it was not until civilian recruiting committees were organized throughout Canada that a sufficient supply of cadets was ensured, and the success of our efforts in establishing training guaranteed.

"You will be interested to know that we have sent overseas 2,538 trained pilots, while we have 552 in Canada, who have completed their training. These figures are considered very remarkable in England.
