# Building Materials of Prince Rupert

By William Bruce, F.E.A.S.A., Architect.

During the transitive period which we are passing through at the present time, when improved methods of construction and conservation are eagerly sought for the writer; of this brief descriptive of the building materials obtainable in the city of Prince Rupert desires to place before the interested citizens the following facts that may be of some value in promoting the growth and development of the city.

The rock on which the city is built is thoroughly fireproof, being of a micaeous nature and at the same time capable of carrying heavy loads, when the pressure is applied on the natural bed of the stone.

It should not be assumed that every piece of stone in the disrict is of good quality, as we find good and bad material in all deposits of rock.
