Social Diseases Danger to Race.

One of the most serious menaces to human health and progress is venereal disease, often spoken of as social disease. At one time it was considered immodest and immoral to speak of this, but the prudes have had their day and now efforts are being made to educate all young men and women in regard to the dangers of the disease. It is the natural outcome of immorality |* and is the hell to which those go who sin in that way. In the report of the Convention of B. C. Municipalities which is just published in the Canadian Municipal Journal Dr. Young, Provincial * Health Officer, is reported as saying in part:

"Someone once, asked the question: When should you begin the education of the child? The suggestive reply was: One hundred years before its birth. I quote this simply because if it is true of the education of the child, then it is doubly true of its |* health; it is true today as it was two thousand years ago, that |* 'the sins of the fathers are visited upon the children.' Therefore it is very necessary that a great deal of attention should be paid to health matters. 




