

To Consist of Three Members Instead of Ten, Effective in Spring.

Dawson, Y. T., Jan. 31. --George Mackenzie, Commissioner for the Yukon, brought word from Ottawa of a reduction in the membership of the Yukon Legislative Council from ten to three, making one member elective from Southern Yukon and two from Northern Yukon with a provision that Northern Yukon be redistributed.
