# BOOTLEGGING IS A FINE ART

Many Clever Tricks Used by Illicit Dealers to Smuggle Liquor Into State.

Spokane, Wash., Jan. 31. -When Montana went "dry" at midnight, December 30, last, by popular vote, the "bootlegger," as the dealer in contraband liquor is popularly called, realized that his day was going, if it had not already gone. Since 1915, when Washington became a prohibition State, the business of bootlegging has been a thriving one and one fraught with little risk to the clever doger of the law.

Officers of the law tell many stories of the ingenuity used in bringing contraband into this state. 
