FISH CATCHES FOR JANUARY KEPT SMALL BY BAD WEATHER

The fish catches for the month of January varied little from the two previous months. Toward the end of the month there was a considerable increase in the boats coming in, but owing to the bad weather the average catches were small.

The prices have been very high, higher than ever before, but now they are on the down grade and promise to go lower.

Many boats have just left for the fishing grounds and it is confidently expected that the catches of the independent and privately owned boats will be larger and more frequent from this time on. Owing to the tieup caused by the disagreement over the shares under the company lay, there will be a distinct loss from the company boats and if the boats remain in harbor long the total for the month of February will be small.

MILD WEATHER AND VERY LITTLE SNOW

At Edson, Alta., it is a general rule to expect below zero weather much of the winter and from three to four feet of snow. But this season the coldest it has reached has been just zero point, and no more snow than what we have here at the present time.

In Edmonton it is the same, very little snow and extremely mild weather. In both places the Chinook winds have been very frequent.

The fire recently at Edson burnt down a whole business block, not a building left on it. It makes the third fire that has swept Edson, taking nearly a whole block each time.

DENIED AUTHORITY OF BRITISH LAWS

Dublin, February 3.—Twelve Sinn Feiners were found guilty Saturday of illegal drilling in a private hall here and sentenced to six months' imprisonment. When arraigned they denied the authority of British laws and waved a republican flag.
