MAY ENDORSE ALL CIVIC APPOINTMENTS

Alderman Perry's Motion Provides For Close Scrutiny By Members of Council.

The notice of motion which has been posted at the City Hall by Alderman Perry in regard to appointments to or dismissals from the civic service reads as follows:

"At a regular meeting of the Prince Rupert City Council to be held on Monday, February 24 inst. I will beg leave to present the following motion: addition to clause 'a', section 98, City Procedure Bylaw:

"Standing committees may receive and endorse the recommendations of the heads of the several civic departments coming under this purview, concerning all appointments to the city's service and changes of salaries contemplated or made; provided always that the committees shall not appoint or discharge employees, this being the prerogative and concern of heads of departments; nevertheless the members of committees shall be made aware, individually and severally, of all appointments or changes contemplated or made as aforesaid, through the chairmen of committees upon receipt by them of reports made from such departmental heads."

WOMEN HOLDING ON TO ALL MEN'S JOBS

Washington, Feb. 18. — Women who took men's jobs for war work are refusing to return to peace pursuits. This is shown today by reports of the United States employment service from all industrial centres of the country.
