### UNITED STATES IS SPENDING MUCH MONEY

Great preparations for the construction of public works and for general building activities in the spring are being made in the United States. In addition to the survey being conducted by the field men of the Division of Public Works and Construction of the United States Department of La-Her friend told her the only bor, the Kelly and Kenyon Bills have been introduced in Congress to provide heavy appropriations for national constructive activities. Each measure calls for an appropriation of \$100,000,000.

The Kenyon Bill, in addition, empowers the War Finance Corporation to make advances, within one year from the passage of the Act, to an aggregate amount not exceeding \$300,000,000, at not less than 5 per cent per annum to any state for financing public works whenever unusual unemployment is actual or threatened.
