MAGNIFICENT BOUNTY

Order in Council Orders Payment to Fishermen and Builders of Fishing Boats.

The award of bounties to be paid to "encourage the development of sea fisheries and the building of fishing vessels," under the Act of 1906, has been authorized and the basis on which the bounties are to be paid fixed by an Order in Council passed on January 30, on the recommendation of the Acting Minister of the Naval Service, as follows:-

His Excellency the Governor General in Council, on the recommendation of the Acting Minister of the Naval Service, is pleased to order and doth hereby order and direct that the sum of one hundred and sixty thousand dollars, payable under the provisions 3 Ottawa St., Hull, P.Q. of Chapter 46 of the Revised | Statutes, 1906, intitled "An Act to encourage the development of the sea fisheries and the building of fishing vessels," shall be distributed for the year 1918-19


