#### Two Sites Suggested For Fishing Centre.

A suggestion has been made in regard to the location of the fish packing houses and the fishermen's boats in this city, with a view to getting them all together and of having improvements made for the benefit especially of the fishermen.

The proposal is that either one of two sites be chosen. The most ideal of these is located in Shawatlans Passage just beyond advertised it in The Daily News For Port Simpson and Naas River Seal Cove near the end of Eleventh Ave. It is said that at this and within an hour after the paper point there is plenty of room, that the railway passes it, that it was on the street the range was Sundays is perfectly protected from all gales and that with Eleventh Ave. extended for a short distance there would be an easy approach. 


