During the period of the war there were distributed to Allied and Canadian hospitals in all 268,119 cases of supplies. To Canadian hospitals in England went 113,813 cases, Canadian hospitals in France, 56,398 cases, Belgium, 4,860 cases, Serbia, 7,-227 cases, Roumania, 4,500 cases.

During the month of February 10,160 cases of supplies were sent overseas from Canada. Of this number 7,572 cases were apples. With apples costing anywhere from 75c. per pound to 65c. each, such a gift, and of such apples, meant much to the men n hospital.
