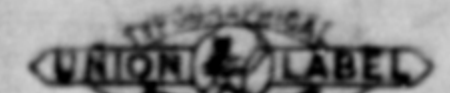

## Doukhobors Do Not Want to Go to Russia.

The Doukhobors do not want to go to Russia. They prefer to remain under the British flag. They are communists, but do not want to trust themselves to the tender mercy of Lenin and his crowd. They know when they are well off for they have lived in Russia and they realize something of what they may expect from the men who are now in authority.

The Doukhobors are a very industrious people. They make their living chiefly from the land, and with so much land in this country it seems a pity that they should have to go farther to seek it. While they are not the best of citizens and no one would like to see the country overrun with them, they might be allowed to remain as long as they are willing to conform to the laws of the country.

## Star Chamber Methods Are Still in Vogue.

A copy of an open letter to Parliament sent by the Ontario branch of the Dominion Alliance takes exception to the prosecution brought by the Crown against Ben Spence, editor and revisor of the Canadian edition of Arthur Mee's book, The Parasite, which was published and circulated in England. The Alliance is asking for a jury trial which is refused by the Crown.

Now that the war is over and the functions of the censorship have ended there should be an end of the attempt to hound those who do not please the big capitalists. The condemned book was distributed to the extent of a million copies or more in the British Isles, but what is good in Great Britain is apparently not good here. "The Parasite" shows up the evils of the liquor business and there are a lot of powerful liquor men at Ottawa who are anxious to see the trade again prospering in this country.

## Irish Prefer to Fight for Rights.

It is useless to repine, but if the people of Great Britain had but seen with W. E. Gladstone when the first Home Rule Bill was proposed, what a lot of trouble it would have saved. There is trouble in Dublin today and there will be fighting in some other city, another day. If Ireland would but stop its nonsense for a few months there would be no difficulty in giving the country home rule, but they do not want to have anything given them. They much prefer to fight for it.

## Tomorrow is Good Friday.

Tomorrow is good Friday, the day which the Christian churches keep in commemoration of the death of Jesus of Nazareth. He was crucified at Calvary, just outside Jerusalem, with a thief on either side.

To many it is a day of grief and mourning, a day for penitential prayer and searching of heart. To others it is looked upon as the day on which a great man died gloriously, something to rejoice at rather than be sad. It was the triumph of the ideal over the material. To the majority, however, it is just a holiday and a time for eating hot cross buns.

## LAND REGISTRY ACT.

## WATER ACT, 1914.

RIPARIAN RIGHTS

NOTICE is hereby given that under the provisions of Section 6 of the Water Act, 1914, every riparian proprietor claiming any right to divert water or to the exclusive use of water for any purpose by virtue only of his being such riparian proprietor is required on or before the first day of June, 1920, to file a statement of claim setting forth the particulars of his claim.
