CANNED WHALE APPEARS HERE ON THE MARKET

New Cucumbers and Asparagus
Both on Sale, and Limberger
Cheese Again Stocked.

Spring vegetables and canned whale are the features of the week on the local market. Asparagus has arrived for the first time and is selling fast at 25c. a bundle. As it becomes more plentiful the price will probably drop somewhat.

Some first rate cucumbers of the hothouse variety are to be seen in the shops today and they fetch 40c. each.

The whale meat is canned and is said to be very good. On account of the name many people do not like trying it, but it must be remembered that whale is not a fish and does not taste fishy. It somewhat resembles beef. Fifty cents a can is the price set on it.

Pork takes a jump this week of five cents a pound. Halibut is cheaper than formerly on account of the drop in the wholesale prices. Limberger cheese is back in the stores, the price being 50c. per pound. The following are the retail prices:

SUGGEST ASSAYERS AT DIFFERENT POINTS

Free Miners' League Makes Suggestions to Minister of Lands To Encourage Mining.

The following memorial has been forwarded to Hon. T. D. Pattullo, Minister of Lands and member for Prince Rupert:

"It is suggested by the Free Miners' League of Prince Rupert that the Minister of Mines appoint licensed assayers at central points throughout the province.

"Furthermore, that the holder of a Free Miners' Certificate, when purchasing his license, receive at the same time, say, five assay coupons, and that these coupons when presented to the assayer appointed for that particular district, will secure for the free miner tests of ore samples at one half of the charges now prevailing, and that the assayer be reimbursed by the Government for the difference in said charges.

"The proposed coupons to be valid for the year of issue only, bearing the name and number of the respective licensees, and to be non-transferable."
