FOOD CONTROL NOW TOO LATE

Berlin People Receive Letters Telling Conditions in Russia.

BERLIN, May 26.—Lenin's abandonment of government control of foodstuffs came too late to relieve the situation in Bolshevik Russia, according to letters received in Berlin from a family which has lived in Petrograd throughout the Bolshevik regime.

STERILE DISTRICTS. The Petrograd district is so sterile that little is produced here in normal times. Transportation is so bad, and the peasants in the grain districts have been so badly treated by the Bolshevik requisitioning parties that the government simply couldn't continue the small rations it was issuing on cards.
