

# SWIMMING PROPOSAL

### Tank Suggested Would Be 17 Feet by 34 Feet in School Basement.

In his report to the Rotary Club yesterday on the proposed swimming tank in the Booth Memorial School, Colonel McMorris said he had examined the site in the basement of the building and found that a suitable room could be made there 23 by 41 feet which would allow the construction of a tank giving a depth of 3 feet of water at one end and seven feet at the other with head room of seven feet and a half. Dressing-rooms and shower baths could be constructed in an adjoining part of the basement.

His plan would give a tank 17 by 34 feet and the cost would approximate \$50,000 inclusive. The construction of the tank would be a simple matter and the heating could be done by the use of the present plant which was plenty large enough to do the work in addition to its present load. This made it possible to keep the cost down. The room would have to be lined out and necessary offices constructed adjoining. The price included all this.

**Question of Finance.**  
Dr. Kerwin, chairman of the school board strongly supported the move and said he thought the city council and school board might be induced to bear half the expense if the Rotary Club managed the other half.

The discussion was general and while all were in favor of the erection of a tank, some thought it should be down town in a central location where it might be used by everyone. Among the suggestions made was one for the establishment of a Y.M.C.A., another for a Y.W.C.A. and a third for a gymnasium and swimming bath with a large assembly hall. Looking after their usual time the members of the club sat and discussed the matter and finally a committee consisting of J. W. Nicholls, Colonel McMorris and F. G. Dawson was appointed to take the matter up with the council and school board to find out what support they might expect.
