CONFER WITH IRISHMEN ON PEACE MATTERS

De Valera Reported Invited to London to Discuss Difficulties with Premier

LONDON, Jan. 8.—Eamonn de Valera, "president of the Irish Republic," is reported to have been invited to come to London to confer with the Prime Minister. Father O'Flanagan, "vice-president," is expected today, coming it is said in connection with the new peace discussions.

SCOTTISH ISLAND ABOLISHES LICENSES

Lewis Votes Overwhelmingly Dry in Recent Campaign.

Stornoway, Scotland, Jan. 7.—The island of Lewis, the largest of the Outer Hebrides, has overwhelmingly voted "dry" in the prohibition poll taken here.

For total abolition there were 720 votes; for no change 149, and for limitation of drink licenses, 5. As a result, all licenses on the island will be annulled next May.

Lewis is a rugged island which abounds in ancient Druidic structures and ruined old-time fortresses.

SMALLPOX AT EDMONTON

Six Cases Reported Since Beginning of Year.

EDMONTON, Jan. 7.—Smallpox, which a short time ago appeared to show some disposition to die out in the city, is again revealing its presence in an unpleasant manner. The officials of the health department are being kept busy, for since the beginning of the year six or more fresh cases have been reported.

A feature of these cases is that they are occurring all over the city, although in a few instances a connection between one and the other may be traced.

In this, however, the smallpox is said to be following a somewhat usual course. It smoulders, as it were, and then shows itself in a number of little outbreaks, often widely separated.

There is no doubt that the control of the disease, so far as the city is concerned, is being handicapped by mild cases having occurred which may not be reported at all, or escape identification for a long period. The sufferers and those connected with them mix with other people, and in this manner the disease is spread.
