STIFF PENALTY DRUG OFFENCES

Prince Rupert Gets Behind Vancouver Recommendations Towards Eradication of Traffic and Use.

The draft of proposed legislation that has been recommended to the federal government for the province of B. C. by the city of Vancouver with the view of eradication of drug using and traffic was last night endorsed by the local council and a telegram is to be sent to the minister of justice telling of this action.

The following are some of the provisions that will appear in the statutes if the Vancouver recommendations are made law: Increased penalties for selling or keeping for sale—first offence, two years in prison and \$1,000 fine; second offence, five years and lashes.
