In reply to one of the members of the unemployed delegation to the city council last night, who emphasized the pitiable state that many men were reduced to, through the lack of employment at the present time, together with the fact that their credit at restaurants and stores was exhausted, Mayor Rochester promised to take the matter up at once with the city engineer and see that immediate relief is provided.

Despite the fact that Alderman Kelly from his professional heights as a master plumber, somewhat scoffed at the worth of a machine known as "an easy pipe pusher," the alderman stating that in soft mud it might be all right but up against roots, rock and Prince Rupert muskeg it was but a paltry toy, upon the recommendation of the board of works it was decided to make the investment, a matter of only \$180. One job where it worked would more than pay for the cost, said Ald. McNeill.
