That man is a ministering member of society and not an individual apart from society was the predominating idea of Archbishop du Vernet in an address to the Rotary Club yesterday.

Man was born into the world as a member of society and could not escape from it. At the same time the individual must be developed in order that the best interests of society may be worked out.

In the opening of his address Archbishop Du Vernet told of the vast territory of which he was a sort of travelling superintendent for his church. He was away from home a good deal and for that reason was not eligible for an institution such as the Rotary Club.
