The Burns Lake rink is in a low spot between the railway track and the east end of town.

If grouse are scarce on the coast, the same certainly cannot be said of the interior country. Around Hazelton, Smithers, Telkwa, Decker Lake, Burns Lake and other up-country places they abound this fall in great numbers and the people there are treating themselves to grouse suppers quite regularly. And the beauty of it is that a person needs only half an hour or so before breakfast to go out and get enough for a fine supper. The birds are more plentiful this season than they have been for years and one runs across them everywhere. Rabbits are also thick this year in the interior after having been scarce for nearly six years. They now have their snowy white coats instead of the greyish brown of summer.
