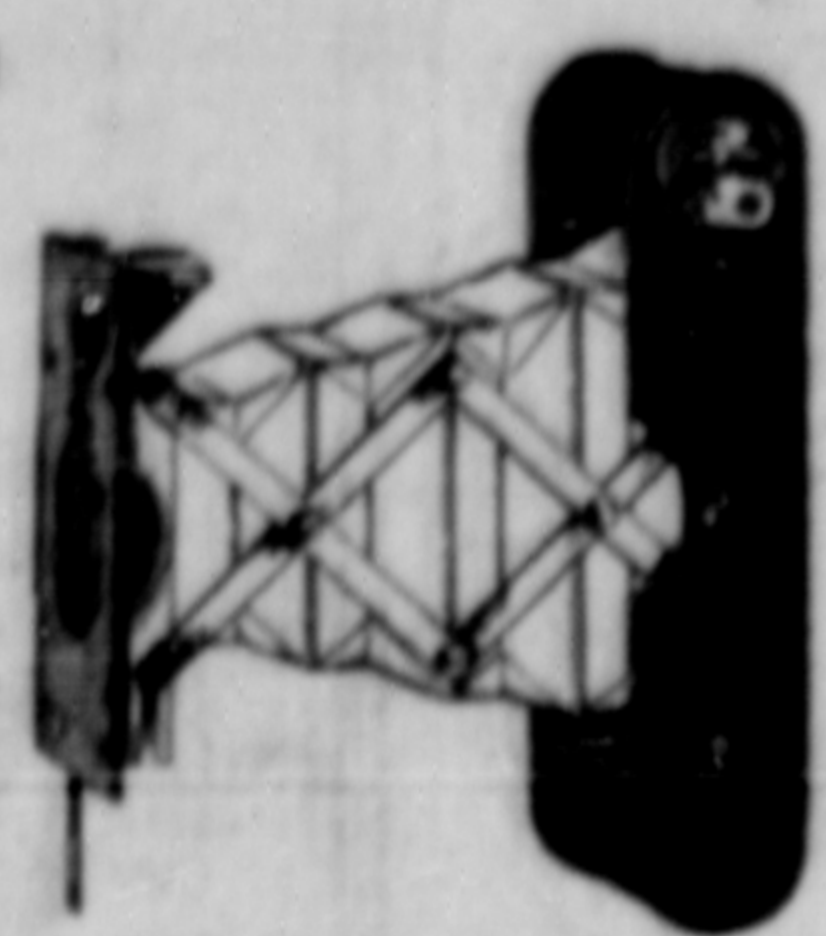

ALASKAN BROWN BEAR PELTS FOR MUSEUM

Rockwell Expedition Obtains Seven Fine Specimens. 168

NEW YORK, July 20.—Word has been received at the Brooklyn Museum to the effect that the expedition led by Robert H. Rockwell, chief taxidermist of the museum, into Alaska, has obtained seven fine specimens of the Alaskan brown bear, the largest carnivorous animal in the world. One of them measured ten feet six inches and was within an inch of being the largest Alaskan brown bear ever killed.

The expedition left for Alaska in April and will return in the early fall. The pelts are in good condition and have been expressed to the museum. They will arrive in a few weeks.

The machine is equipped with a Universal transmission overdrive which will give it greater speed. The new motor will doubtless prove an invaluable addition to the municipal fire fighting equipment.
