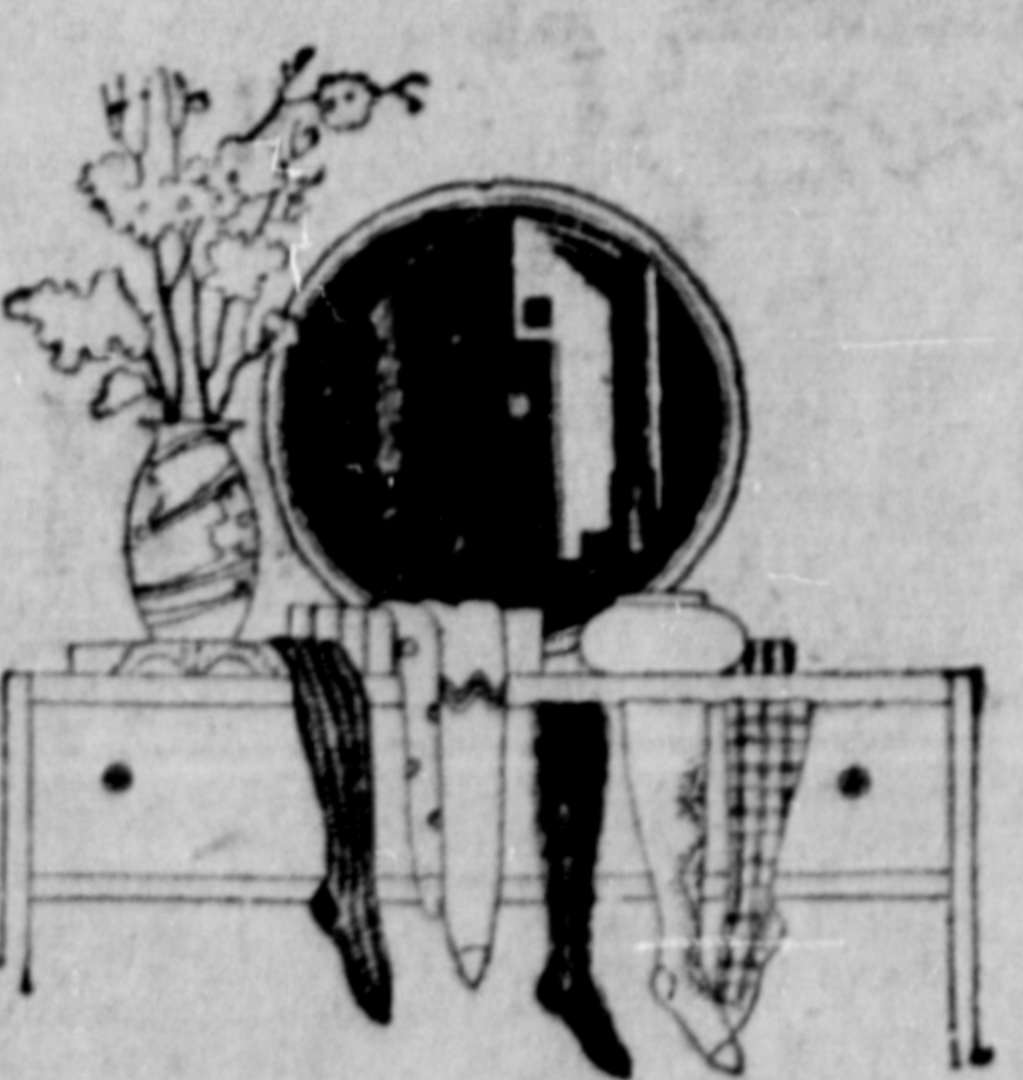

ALL NIGHT SESSION OF SCHOOL BOARD IN CITY OF REGINA

REGINA, April 19. - It took the school board just ten hours to decide the various items on the agenda before the motion for adjournment passed. Itlessly as a-sisties and clocks were sounding for six a.m. By several hours it was the longest session in the history of that body governing the destinies of Regina's public school system.

As far as salaries are concerned the result of the long deliberation means a lump increase of approximately \$6,000 over and above scheduled increases that would under the ordinary course of events have come into effect September 1 next. While not meeting all the demands presented by the Teachers' Alliance, the new salary scale is considerably higher for principals, some of them getting as high as four hundred dollars tacked on to their stipends.

With the natural increase and the higher rate adopted last night Regina will pay her teachers next year about \$7,500 more than this year.
