Arming of the Moplahs was said to be in violation. of the Malabar Offensive Weapons Act of 1851. Sikhs and other native Indian police, as well as agitators sympathizing with the Gandhi anti-British boycott, have been charged with supplying the Moplahs with weapons and inciting them to rebellion.

### Doub'e Faced.

he Nationalist leader, at a congress held late in 1920 in Nagour, made a plea against violence but called for the destruction of British rule in India and was quoted as saying that the success of the non-cooperation movement-the refusal of Indians to pay taxes, send their children to school or buy British products-might involve "wading through oceans of blood.


