Tale of a Wonderful Waterspout that Followed Steamer and Succumbed to Siren

NEW YORK, May 13.—Ever since a British passenger liner tied up here recently with the tale of a huge waterspout being tossed upon her decks off the coast of Ireland, ship captains have been engaged in a competition of wild adventures which are related as the boat's steam up past quarantine.

This is the experience which Captain Avery of the Ward liner Esperanza enters in the story-tellers' sweepstakes for the tissue paper spinnaker.

Between Progresso, Yukatan, and Havana, a week ago, the look-out sighted a waterspout a mile high several miles astern of the Esperanza, but rapidly overhauled the ship. Capt. Avery zig-zagged to escape it, but when he zipped the spout zipped and when the Esperanza zipped so did the spout.

For two hours this went on, the spout always one turn astern of the Esperanza.

At last the resourceful skipper bethought himself of the steam siren and blew a blast at full boiler pressure.

And, presto! the air vibration caused by the whistle jiggled the spout so severely that it took a dead fall into the sea and the ship was saved.
