EASTER MUSIC BEING PREPARED

Church Choirs Practising for the
Coming Festive Season
Following Lent.

Considerable activity is being
displayed among the local musi-
cians in connection with the vari-
ous churches these days. The pen-
itential season is now well on,
and the advent of Easter will be
celebrated gaily in a few weeks.
Choiristers are putting in lots
of practice and from the en-
thusiasm being shown in various
quartets, some very well rendered
music may be expected. Stainer's
"Credo" is in course of prepara-
tion at the Methodist Church for
Good Friday, the solo parts of
which will be taken by local sing-
ers. This oratorio is one of the
classics and is a source of never-
fading delight both to the sing-
ers and the audience. The choruses
give ample scope for the capabili-
ties of choirs, soloists and
conductor. Some other of Hand-
el's choruses—and no composer
ever did better work than Handel—
are also to be rendered.

MOLTEN METAL IS WATERFRONT SIGHT

Recently Installed Foundry Proves
Useful to Fisherfolk of
This Port.

One of the interesting develop-
ments in the business of the
water front is the recent installa-
tion of a foundry at Akorberg,
Thomson & Co.'s shop. Although
the foundry was intended for
brass, other metals can be run as
well. Hitherto this work was done
at the dry dock plant or sent be-
low, which in the latter case was
troublesome and tedious. There
are innumerable castings of brass
required in the engine repair
business and when they can be
made on the spot, business is
much facilitated. The alloy can
be made as required in the cruci-
ble, whether bright brass or
bronze. A sand specially suitable
for moulding has been secured at
Telkwa, where it is shipped here.

Economy is the chief feature
which interests local engine own-
ers. In a recent instance a boat
came to port with one of her prop-
eller blades stripped. Not long
ago this would have meant a new
propeller. Nowadays, a mould is
taken of the blade with the exact
pitch, a new one cast and then
welded on to the wheel by an oxy-
acetylene flame.
