#### Synopsis of Land Act Amendments

Pre-emption new confined to our Records will be granted covering only land suitable for agriculturel purposes and which is non-timber land.

Partnership pre-emptions abolished, but parties of not more than four may with joint residence, but each making necessary improvements on respective

Pre-emptore must occupy claims for five years and make improvements to value of \$10 per acre, including clearing and cultivation of at least 5 acres, before receiving Crown Grant. Where pre-emptor in occupation not less than I years, and has made proportionate improvements, he may, be-cause of ill-health, or other cause, be granted intermediate certificate of improvement and transfer his claim.

dence may be issued, provided applicant makes improvements to extent of year. Fallure to make improvements or record same will operate as forof \$10.00 per acre, including 5 acres cleared and cultivated, and residence of at least 2 years are required.

Pre-emptor holding Crown grant may record another pre-emption, if he requires land in conjunction with his
