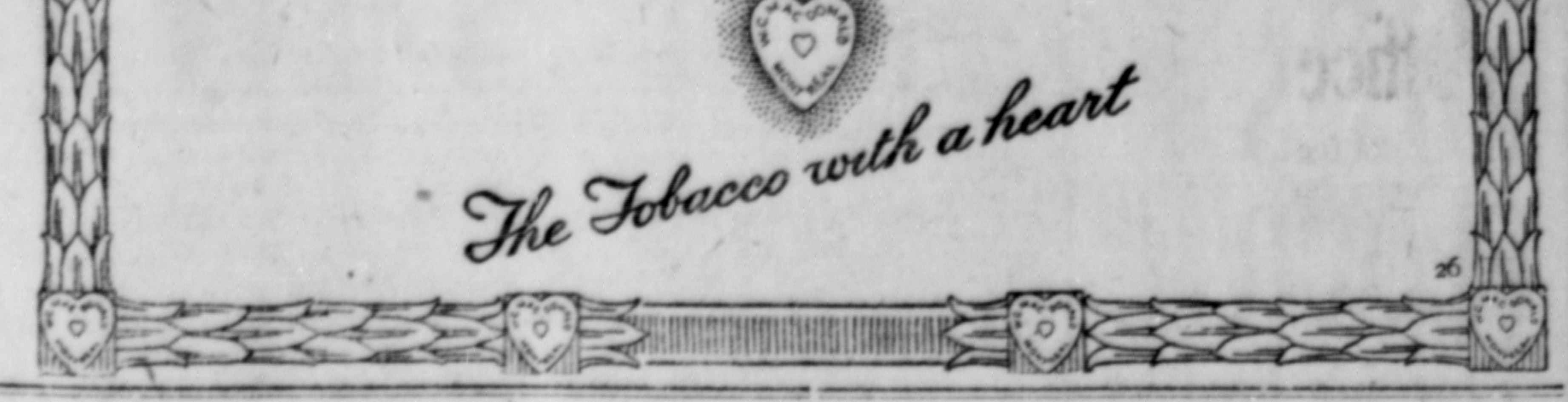
**For Vegetarians.**
