The accused stated that he had only made one run on the night in question, that being to the Marine Ironworks with Joe West, who substantiated this statement. The bills which had been found in the glove of the accused had been placed there at Christmas time when he had changed them for smaller bills with J. Harris, a restaurant man, who is to be put on the stand this afternoon.
