STOCK SELLERS FIND CLIMATE TOO WARM TO STAY IN PROVINCE
VANCOUVER, Oct. 26.—Promoters for an American automobile factory have changed their mind about exploiting their enterprise here, following warning issued by the authorities of Chicago. It was stated the principals have been in trouble with the blue sky laws several times. It was announced that they would start a factory for turning out cheap, strong cars of the "divver" type. Local investors were offered places on the directorate. The promoters, however, departed before they had opportunity to sell any stock here.
"The authorities of Vancouver and Victoria are 'getting after' wild cutting projects, and the newspapers are careful about accepting dubious promotion stock advertising. There has been an exodus of the stock salesmen lately. With few exceptions, they were Americans."
