## WILL REOPEN MILL GISCOM IN SPRING

For the purpose of re-opening the modern lumber mill at the Giscom, west of Edmonton, A. E. Frost, of Chicago, is a visitor in the city and on Friday morning was conducting negotiations that will result in the mill being reopened in the spring of next year, says the Edmonton Bulletin.

The Giscom Lumber Company commenced operations about three years ago when it introduced to the milling industry one of the most modern plants in Western Canada. Owing to the lack of efficient management and general lethargical business conditions, the mill was closed down about two years ago.

To The Bulletin Friday Mr. Frost remarked that business possibilities for the early future were exceptionally bright. He declared he had found an increased enthusiasm in all lines of commerce and that he was looking forward to a considerable amount of building activity during the spring and summer of 1922.

BY-LAW NO. 1  
A BY-LAW TO CONFIRM AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE PRINCE RUPERT PULP & PAPER COMPANY LIMITED AND THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT.

WHEREAS on the 9th day of August A.D. 1921, an Agreement was entered into between the Prince Rupert Pulp & Paper Company Limited and the City of Prince Rupert, which agreement was in the words and figures following:

1. This Agreement made in duplicate this 9th day of August, 1921, BETWEEN PRINCE RUPERT PULP & PAPER COMPANY LIMITED, a body corporate incorporated under the laws of the Province of British Columbia, hereinafter called the "COMPANY" AND THE CITY OF PRINCE RUPERT, a body corporate, incorporated by Statute of the Province of British Columbia, hereinafter called the "CITY".

The Company proposes to establish in the City of Prince Rupert, in the Province of British Columbia, a Pulp Mill which will require in its operation a substantial supply of water, and the Company proposes to take the water from the City water mains and to install a pump to lift the water from the City water mains to the mill. 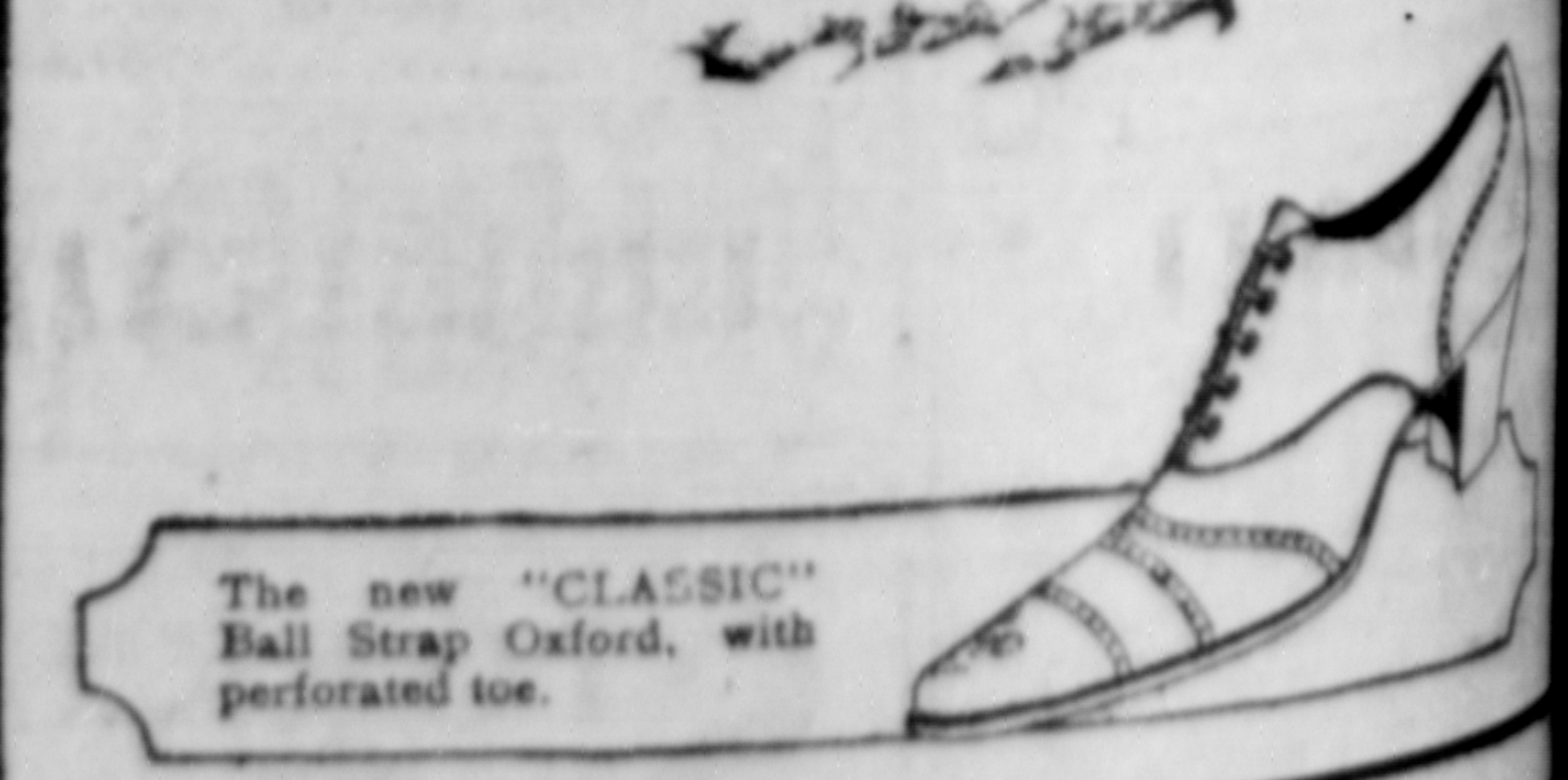
