FUTURE OF MOUNTIESMatter Is Discussed at Ottawa—
Numbers Likely Reduced.

OTTAWA, March 29.—The future of the Dominion and Royal Mounted Police is creating a good deal of speculation. The former are at present absorbed in the latter, making a total force of over sixteen hundred men. The period of engagement of what is known as "the 1919 class" expires in June next, when some six hundred men will either be allowed to go or be re-enlisted. The present probability is that they will be dropped. There is a good deal of speculation in the western provinces as to whether the police will be retained there or not. In the House the other day a British Columbia member, Mr. Neill, of Comox-Alberni, urged that they be removed from that province, where he said they were no longer needed as they had their provincial police.

The minister of militia recently communicated with the governments of the different provinces, asking them to express an opinion as to whether the retention of the Mounted Police was desirable or not, and is now awaiting this advice before formulating a definite policy regarding them.

**KEVIN OIL WELL
IS EXPECTED TO BE
HEAVY PRODUCER**

LETHBRIDGE, March 29.—The new oil well south of here and a short distance across the border gives every indication of being the best well yet brought in in the state of Montana. It is in Toole County. Two gas sands were struck, the first at 1010 feet and the second at 1550 feet. These were high in gasoline content, producing oil sand with heavy gas pressure was found at 1770 feet.

A test is to be made for production just as soon as the tanks are in place.

There is a big rush to the district, not only on the American side but in the district on the Alberta side of the boundary line.
