City Requests Prime Minister to Bring Silver Question Before Conference

Having been redrafted since last meeting by Mayor Orme and City Solicitor Jones and certain undesirable features of the original draft eliminated, Ald. Casey's resolution requesting Prime Minister R. B. Bennett to bring the gold and silver question before the forth-| coming world economic conference was unanimously adopted by the city council last night.

The resolution expresses the belief that some fundamental reason exists for the present depression and cessation of production and employment and requests the Prime Minister to impress upon the economic conference the advisability of carefully inquiring into the relation of silver and gold in regard to monetary system and, if possible, establish a fair ratio be-
