## MAKE WOMEN EQUAL TO MEN

### In the Letter Box

#### OPENING OF SEVENTH ST.

Editor Daily News:

I have read the City Engineer's letter in your issue of Saturday answering mine of a few days ago.

He furnishes figures of street grades most of which differ very little from those I gave, while the others are evidently not the grades of the places I specified, notably his figure of 2.75 for the east end of Third Avenue. This would appear to be the grade on Third Avenue West of McBride Street, the dividing line between east and west, while the grade just thereto is about six and one-half per cent. However, these details of grades are not the really important aspect of the case and I would not have referred to them at all but for the engineer's statement that there was something wrong if any man thought of heavy traffic being carried over a five per cent grade.

The simple fact is that heavy traffic is being carried over that and much higher grades in this and many other cities.

#### FAVOS'S SEVENTH.

The engineer does not refute any of the facts I stated in support of the Seventh Street route, and in condemnation of Eleventh Street—which latter he is reported as favoring. These facts still stand, challenging successive refutation, both as regards the absolute unsuitability of the Eleventh Street and the overwhelming merits and claims of the Seventh Street route.

In addition to the numerous stores of the western section of the city all the hotels except one, several large apartment and rooming houses, the leading places of amusement, most of the restaurants, and the main taxi stands are in the immediate vicinity of Seventh Street, in fact they cluster around it, and for all these the Seventh Street route to trains and steamers would be incomparably the most convenient and economical for both passengers and freight, and it should not be forgotten that for passenger traffic the first essential is saving time.

The Eleventh Street route would send the vast majority of passengers four blocks farther west than is necessary and of course they would have to return over the same distance to reach their destination.

A five or six per cent grade being quite feasible for the very short roadway from Seventh Street to the station, and that street having been made extra wide so as to be specially suitable for a main thoroughfare to the waterfront, it is hard to understand how or why any other route should be adopted.
