Anglo-Canadian Pact Is Approved by Both London and Ottawa

Division in Canadian Parliament Last Night Was 128 to 80—Old Country Legislators Vote 416 to 68 in Favor of Agreement

OTTAWA, Nov. 4:—A few hours after the British Parliament had voted its final approval, the Canadian House of Commons last night ratified the Anglo-Canadian trade treaty, negotiated at the recent Imperial economic conference in Ottawa, by a vote of 128 to 80. Conservative members voted en bloc in favor of ratification and were joined

by one Liberal, J. L. Ilsley, Hants-Kings, Nova Scotia and six Progressives. The remainder of the Liberal, Progressive, United Farmer, Independent and Labor members voted WEEK NOW against the treaty.




