CENTER AND GUARDS

Important Position

One of the most important positions on the basketball team is that of center and a few words regarding this position may not come amiss.

The center is the pivot man, as a rule, of all team plays both defensive and offensive, For that reason he must be accomplished in all the arts which we have discussed in regard to the forward and at the same time must possess the qualifications of a good guard. He is usually a dall man so that he can secure the ball at the tip-off although some v ery good jumpers are to be found among the men of shorter statue. In selecting center ability to get the jump along with the following qualifications must be considered.
