IS GOVERNED IN
PRINCE RUPERT****Rules of Prince Rupert Baseball Association As Adopted at Annual Meeting.**

All last steps have been taken by the Prince Rupert Baseball Association towards having the sport organized in affiliation with the Amateur Athletic Union. The association started something at its annual meeting on Tuesday night the need for which has long been felt in this city and it is to be hoped that the present communication to the provincial union will result in some definite action being taken towards having the local sport thus identified. It is expected that there may be difficulties in the way, especially as far as the older players are concerned, but there seems to be no reason why a long step in this direction might not be taken now. As time goes on the necessity makes itself more and more apparent.

The objects of the League are to encourage amateur baseball and develop local athletes as much as possible.

It is understood that all players in the league are to be strictly amateur and the executive reserves the right to disqualify any player if sufficient proof is furnished that he has accepted money for playing in the league, or for other than legitimate expenses, as provided for by the B. C. A. A. U., and further that any games played in by such disqualified player shall be forfeited.

The officers of the league shall consist of a president, first vice-president, second vice-president and secretary-treasurer.

The entrance fee to the league shall be five dollars, payable by each club before the first game is played.

Registration of Players.

1. No Club shall have more than 15 players registered at one time.

2. Players to be resident in Prince Rupert at least 15 days before being eligible to be signed on with any club.

3. Players are to be registered with the League secretary at least 48 hours before the first game in which they are to participate.

4. Any bona fide resident attending school or college outside of the city, or absent from the city on vacation or business shall be exempt from paragraph 2.

Registration Forms.

1. Fifteen forms to be given each club upon receipt of their entrance fee and further forms to be supplied by the secretary on application.

2. The league secretary must be notified of the release of any player and the form signed by said player must be turned in and cancelled.

Transfers.

1. Any player has the right to apply for transfer from one team to another provided he has not had the privilege of playing in any of three consecutive games of his club and had notified his own club that he is applying for a transfer.

2. All transfers shall be dealt with by the executive.

Gate Receipts.


1. All gate receipts to be handed by the League treasurer.

2. The league to supply all balls and field equipment necessary for the games.

3. Surplus receipts to be divided once a month on a basis of 50 per cent to the league and 50 per cent to be divided equally among the clubs.

Protests.

All protests to be made on the field to the official umpire and a written notice of same to be given to the secretary within 24 hours.
