Water in Basement—I have looked in vain for water in the basement. There was water in the excavation for the swimming tank but this comes through a fissure in the rock and cannot be stopped unless the tank is built or the excavation filled up to the level of the drainage system.

General construction—I am surprised at the term "merely a shell" being applied especially when the amount of solid brick-work and the anchorage is known. In the matter of the auditorium, the fact that the front walls are stiffened by four large piers, the end walls by abutting walls and the rear walls with the ceiling and main roof are evidently not considered.
