**CAPTAIN FREEMAN STATES  
REASON FOR TAKING LAW  
INTO OWN HANDS: IS FREE**

the top of the stairs he was advised to stand back. Capt. Freeman was standing in the corridor outside the customs house door. It was dark and the lights in the hall were out but he recognized Capt. Freeman's voice as he was talking to Mr. Wynn. He said, "I am going to get satisfaction." Mr. Wynn informed witness that it was Capt. Freeman and he had a gun. Then witness heard the action of the gun and the captain said, "Nobody is going to get in here except over my dead body." He talked to Mr. Wynn a few minutes and advised him (Wynn) to go and get the assistance of the police. Witness then went downstairs and met Constable Cameron. In answer to Mr. Craig, witness asserted that he had been unable to get to his duties in the office on account of Capt. Freeman. He did not see Capt. Freeman again that day and it was 4:30 before he got in the office.

On being asked if he had any question for the witness, Capt. Freeman said:

"Had you any idea that the defendant had a grievance against the government?"

Mr. Nelson—Yes.

Replying to another question by Captain Freeman, Mr. Nelson declined to express an opinion as to whether or not he (Freeman) had been treated fairly by the department. He believed, however, that Capt. Freeman's grievance had been the reason for his holding up the customs house.

### Wynne's Evidence

John Wynne told of going to the customs office at 5 minutes to 9. Shortly after Capt. Freeman walked into the hall and asked when the office opened. Witness said nine o'clock and Capt. Freeman said it would not open that day. Accused had a rifle in his hand and said that he had a grievance which he was going to bring to a head. Witness then proceeded to walk up and down the hall and Capt. Freeman said, "Stop, if you come any further I will shoot." Accused seemed excited and not himself.
