#### Hon. Frank Oliver Friend Of The West.

It did not take Hon. Frank Oliver long to express himself on the matter of railway rates after he was appointed to the Railway Commission. A report received today quotes him as saying that the rate westward to Prince Rupert and Vancouver should be the same as for a similar distance eastward. He does not believe in high rates just to protect the C.P.R., which built a very costly system over the mountains, whereas the Canadian National was built expressly for the purpose of avoiding this costly mountain haul.

In the appointment of Hon. Frank Oliver to the Railway Commission we see another evidence of the friendliness of the present government toward the west and its determination to uphold the Canadian National Railway.
