SYNOPSIS OF LAND ACT AMENDMENTS

Minimum price of first-class and reduced to \$5 an acre; second-class to \$2.50 an acre. Pre-emption now confined to surveyed lands only.

PRE-EMPTORS' FREE GRANTS ACT.

The scope of this Act is enlarged to include persons joining and serving with the Majesty's Forces. The time within which the heirs or devisees of a deceased pre-emptor may apply for title under the Act is extended from one year from the death of such person, as formerly, until one year after the conclusion of the great war.
