A valuable little handbook entitled "Hints to Hunters," giving suggestions for the use of equipment in the dressing and care of game has been published by the Department of Interior of the Federal Government at Ottawa. The book gives instruction as to dressing, bleeding, dressing, skinning and cutting up venison and deer in a like manner with ducks and other game birds. Suggestions with respect to buying of game are also given and diseases and parasites are mentioned. The Department of Health has also appended to the booklet suggestions for hunters with respect to pure water, as possessing, storing, drinking, cooking and food etc. A final chapter urges care in carrying firearms and urges against the deterioration of wild game.

To every a gun without port to human life or limb is the A-B-C of its use says the book. "There's death in the pot," such constant care is required to avoid accidents that no man can give it by continual voluntary efforts, safe carriage of the gun must become an unconscious habit. First as the movement of an automatic. The proper rule and whole sense of the muzzle must never cross the horizon, accidental discharge should send the shot into the ground before your feet, or away up in the air. There are several safe and easy ways of holding a gun; they will be employed by those to whom particular accidents when happened. 1. Hold in the hollow of the arm, preferably the left, as you can recover to aim in less time than from the right, across the front of your person, the hand on the gun, the muzzle elevated about 45 degrees. 2. Hang it by the trigger guard attached over the five-arm shoulder strap to the breast, the stock passing behind the upper arm, the muzzle pointing to the ground a pace or so in front of you. 3. Shoulder it, the hand on the top or back-plate, the muzzle pointing upward at least 45 degrees. 4. Shoulder it reversed, the hand grasping the barrels about their middle, the muzzle pointing forward and downward; this is perfectly admirable, but is the most awkward position of all to recover from.
