NEW SHINGLE MILL TO BE ERECTED VICTORIA

Puget Sound Lumber and Timber Co. Erecting One at Cost of \$35,000

VICTORIA, Nov. 30. — After negotiations with the city on foreshore rights the Canadian Puget Sound Lumber & Timber Company, Ltd., have arrived at a decision which has enabled them to commence work on the erection of a four machine shingle mill with two concrete double dry kilns on their property on Wood Street, near the old Rock Bay Bridge. The building permit taken out at the City Hall placed the work at \$15,000. When the four machines are installed the total expenditure will be in the neighborhood of \$35,000, states J. D. Kissinger, manager of the company.

The new plant, which will operate all the year round, will employ about thirty men each shift, and when the market warrants two shifts will operate. The company figures on an output of 120,000 shingles in a single shift, or a total of 240,000 shingles a day when a double shift is working.

The new plant will hold a lot of work for Victoria which has been going outside. In the past the company have imported a great quantity of cedar logs, and have many on hand which have been accumulating. Instead of the logs being exported for the making of shingles, the shingles will be made in Victoria. A good market is anticipated in the prairies and in Eastern Canada, and it is also hoped to ship quantities to the Atlantic Coast by water. The city has agreed to release the foreshore rights to the company for a period of twenty-one years with an option of renewal, and with the stipulation that the rights shall revert to the city during that time, on one year's notice, should they be needed for railroad purposes.

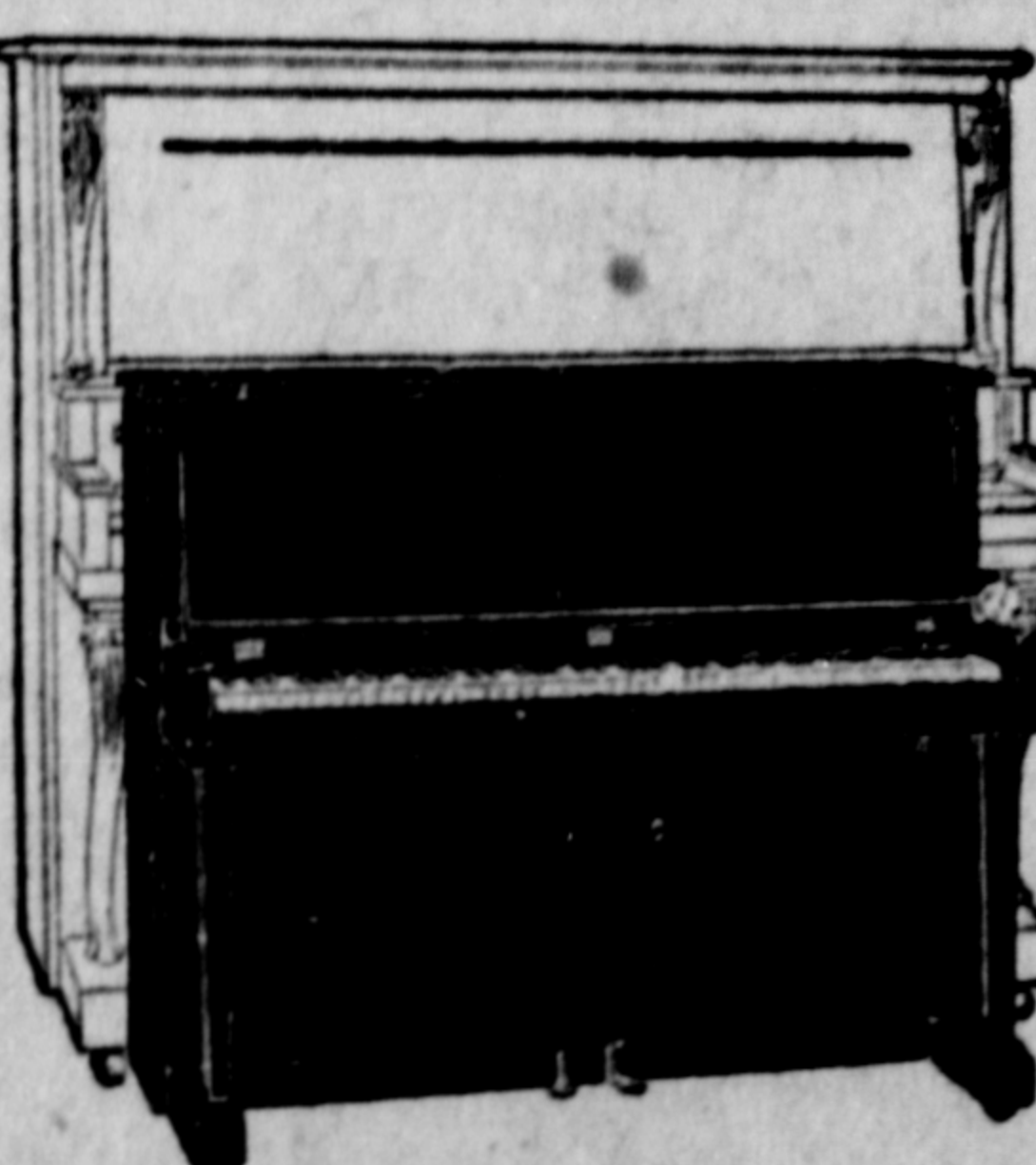
