## ONE CAR FOR THIRTEEN IN THE PROVINCE

There are 39,000 Autos in Use in B.C. It is Announced

VICTORIA, Nov. 10. — Some idea of the increase in the prosperity of the people of British Columbia is reflected in the fact that there are at the present time 39,000 automobiles under the provincial registry. This is all the more striking when it is considered that even as recently as 1916 there were very few more than 8,000 automobiles. This compilation of statistics recently completed by Dr. Sutherland, minister of public works, indicates that there is about one motor car to every 13 people in the province.

After several personal inspections of the highways of the Province, Dr. Sutherland is naturally seized with the importance of preserving good road surfaces in order that there may be a greater interchange of visits between people in various parts of the province, and also a larger inducement for the automobiling tourist to come to this part of the country from adjoining provinces and from the various neighboring and farther distant States of the Union.

One indication of the greater facilities offered to the automobilist by the completion of various highways of a connecting nature, and the improvement of other roads throughout the Province, can be understood from the fact that in 1917 it required the best part of two days to go by road from Nelson to Trail, whereas it is now possible to do the journey by automobile in 2½ hours.

## PROVES VALUE OF IRRIGATED LANDS

Minister of Lands Gives Instance of Profits to be Made South Okanagan

VICTORIA, Nov. 10. — It is a simple matter to criticize expenditure upon public works when such works are in an unfinished state and present a spectacle of only moderate production to the uninitiated. But when it is understood that already in the provincial government area of irrigated lands in the South Okanagan \$150 net profit per acre is the return from the growing of cantaloups, it will be observed how very dangerous it is to jump at conclusions, instead of waiting until a practical demonstration has proved the merit or demerit of an undertaking of any public nature.

According to an announcement just made by Mr. Pattullo, minister of lands, the cost of growing cantaloups in the area above referred to is \$50 per acre. This figure includes the cost of seed, ploughing, cultivating, irrigating, picking, water tax, and also the interest on deferred payments on the land. Detailed statistics in respect of this particular enterprise show that something like 200 cases of cantaloups per acre, at \$1 per case, or \$200 per acre, constitute the return in bulk. From this already has been deducted the cost of cases, packing, freight and all handling charges. In some cases, however, crops have reached 300 cases to the acre according to reliable information which has been furnished by Mr. Pattullo.

Before the government turned its attention to this particular tract and supplied it with its water it was nothing better than a desert.

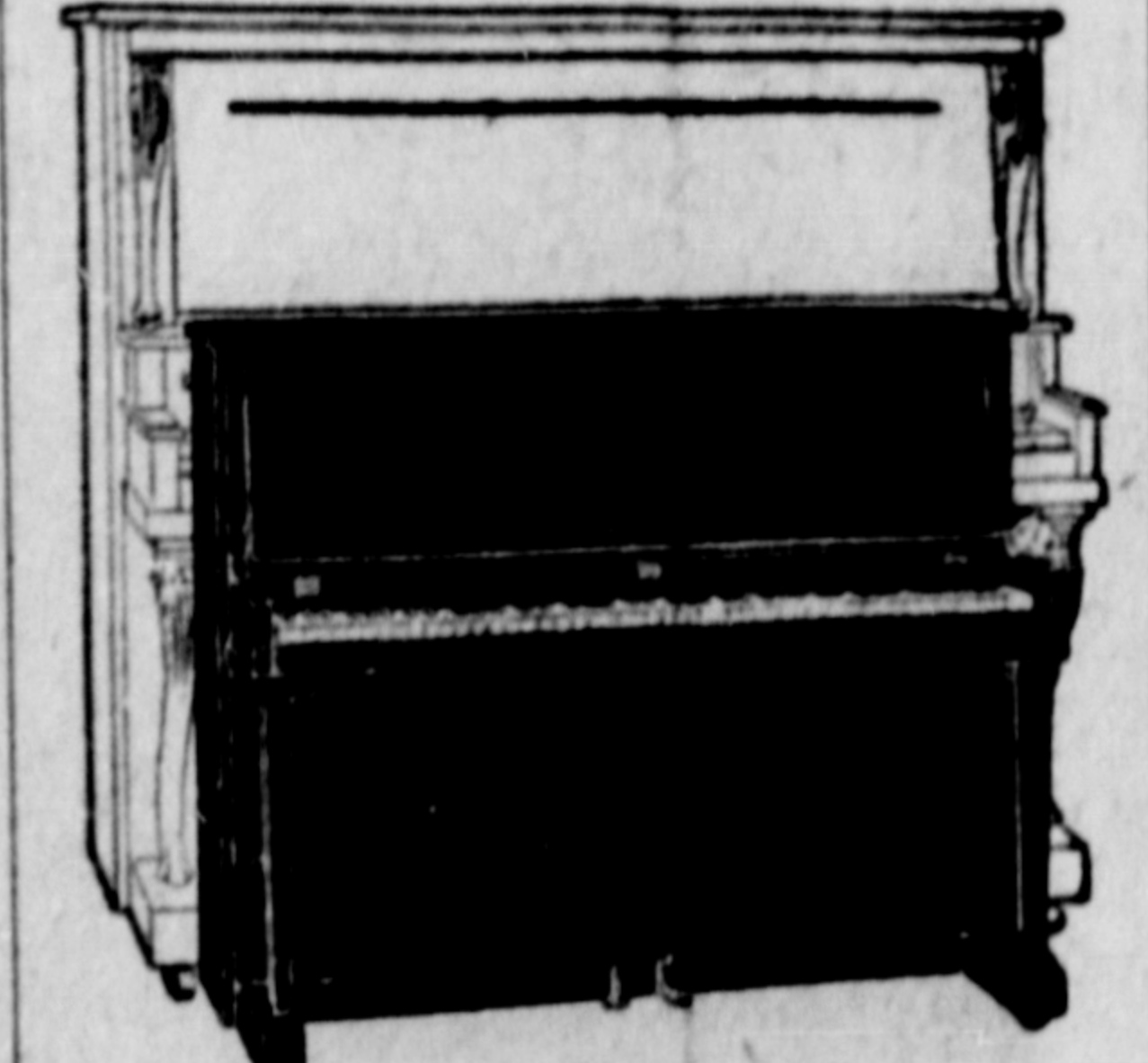
