Position of Church Funds Following Machray Misappropriations is Mentioned

Rev. Dr. T. B. R. Westgate of Winnipeg, western secretary of the Missionary Society of the Canadian Church and assistant director of the campaign to raise funds to replace church money following the Machray misappropriations, was the preacher last evening in St. Andrew's Anglican Cathedral here. In the course of his sermon, Dr. Westgate discussed the position of church funds as a result of the Machray disclosures.

Dr. Westgate arrived in the city yesterday afternoon on the Cardena from Vancouver and will be here until Wednesday morning when he will proceed east by train. During his stay here he is the guest of Bishop and Mrs. G. A. Rix at the Bishop's Lodge, Fourth Avenue West.

STORY IS DRAMATIC

"The Night of June 13" is Feature Picture at Capitol Theatre

The drama that sometimes goes on back of the quiet facades of commonplace suburban homes provides the basis of the action for "The Night of June 13," the film which is being featured at the Capitol Theatre here the first of this week. The story deals with four families whose lives and fates have become rather intricately tangled and the tale is as exciting in its nearness to everyday existence as its melodrama.

The film culminates in an unusual courtroom scene with Clive Brook nearly convicted of murdering his wife, Adrienne Allen. In addition to Brook and Miss Allen, fine performances are turned in by Mary Boland, as a nosy neighbor, by Charlie Ruggles, as her husband, by Charlie Grapewin, as grandpapa, by Lila Lee, as the innocent cause of all the trouble, and by Gene Raymond and Frances Dee as two young lovers. It is a strange story of commonplace people but is told uncommonly well.

"The Night of June 13" is said to be as entertaining as any film that has come along in a long time.

JUDGMENT RESERVED

Trial of Action Against Four Dominion Fisheries Officials Nears Its Close

Judgment has been reserved by Chief Justice Aulay Morrison in Supreme Court at Vancouver on the claim of the Canadian Credit Men's Trust Association, trustees in bankruptcy for the Somerville Cannery Co., to recover damages from four Dominion Fisheries officers for alleged interference six years ago with the firm's floating salmon cannery, Laural Whalen, at Ferguson Bay, Massett Inlet.

At the close of the trial E. C. Mayers, K.C., counsel with Milton Gonzales for the plaintiff, obtained leave to increase the claim from \$70,915 to \$87,137 damages. If counsel are unable to agree on the loss suffered by the Somerville Cannery Co., further evidence will be heard by the chief justice on the issue if necessary.

Defendants in the action are Alex Johnston, former deputy minister of fisheries, W. A. Found, his successor and former director of fisheries, J. A. Motherwell, chief supervisor of fisheries for British Columbia, and Adam Mackie, supervisor at Vancouver and formerly at Prince Rupert. W. E. Burns, K.C., and O. F. Lundell are counsel for the defendants.

Mrs. Overn Loses In Higher Court

Application For Writ of Attachment Denied By British Columbia Court of Appeal

The British Columbia Court of Appeal has dismissed with costs an appeal of Mrs. Elizabeth Overn of Vancouver against dismissal by Chief Justice Aulay Morrison in Supreme Court of her application of a writ of attachment against Sheriff E. S. Peters of Prince George for failure to pay into court the whole of a sum of \$4949 involved in connection with a sale some years ago of Mrs. Overn's trading post north of Prince George. The sale was later held by the courts to have been illegal and Mrs. Overn was awarded damages.
