## SYNTHETIC IMITATION BOOZE IN MANITOBA

Drugs and Essences Used for Making Liquor Found in Lumber Shed

WINNIPEG, Mar. 29.—Drugs, ether, essences, and oils of various kinds—sleep inducers and kick producers—are among the discoveries made by Ontario law officers in the old premises of the Rat Portage Lumber company at Rainy River, occupied by the United Shippers, Limited, whose alleged illegal activities have brought down on them the displeasure of the law, according to a special despatch to the Free Press from Fort Frances. Thousands of bottles, unwashed, but with labels on them, are among the finds, and it is the opinion of authorities these have been collected from Winnipeg and other centres with a view to their use in the bottling of the company's goods.

After a visit of investigation to the premises, at Rainy River, one of the prohibition enforcement officers said he did not believe there was a pint of liquid on the place that was "honest liquor." He said the stuff shipped away was made up of the oils and essences and water, the water being taken direct from the river, without even going through any cleansing process.

This liquor, he said, was made by the admixture of the various drugs and essences named, in order to give the drinker the impression he was getting the real thing. "But," he added, "there is not a drop that is not synthetic, imitation booze. I know, because I've—" The smile with which he ended the sentence was entirely innocent, quite synthetic, as it were.
