Editor, Daily News. I read with interest your editorial on the liquor situation and note that you laid great stress on the financial aspect but said little about the moral degeneracy which follows the excessive use of alcoholic stimulants.

Possibly you have had no experience with people who have given to the liquor habit.

I want to say this, that not only does the man who drinks to excess make a beast of himself but he is never safe and neither are the people who mingle with them. The insidious action of alcohol on the brain generally destroys all the better impulses or so weakens them that they become ineffective.

Under the influence of liquor even the moderate drinker will do things that he would not think of doing in his saner moments.

The sex impulses become strong and the part of the brain that usually acts as a brake does not function.

The effect of alcohol on women is just as bad as on men, perhaps worse. They are usually better than men when absolutely sober but when under the influence ever so little become degraded and lose their true womanliness.

There are in the country around, however, many people who are beginning to make their living from keeping cows and every year the conviction is growing that dairying is the great industry of the future in many of the fertile valleys of central B.C. and on Vancouver Island.

GERMANY AGAIN IS SELLING TO FRENCH

Stock of French Wines on Hand in Ruhr is for Consumption of Visitors

BERLIN, Nov. 21.—French wines, French perfumes and French food supplies of various sorts came back into the German market with a rush immediately after the announcement of Chancellor Stresemann that the passive resistance in the Ruhr was at an end. Bills of fare in prominent cafes and restaurants again are being written in French, and all the signs declaring French and Belgians would not be served have been removed.

Most of the larger German hotels and cafes had extensive cellars filled with French wines. Much of this has been sold as Italian or Spanish wine during the passive resistance period, but the Spanish and Italian labels have now been replaced by French labels, and customers who have been clamoring for French wine are happier.
